

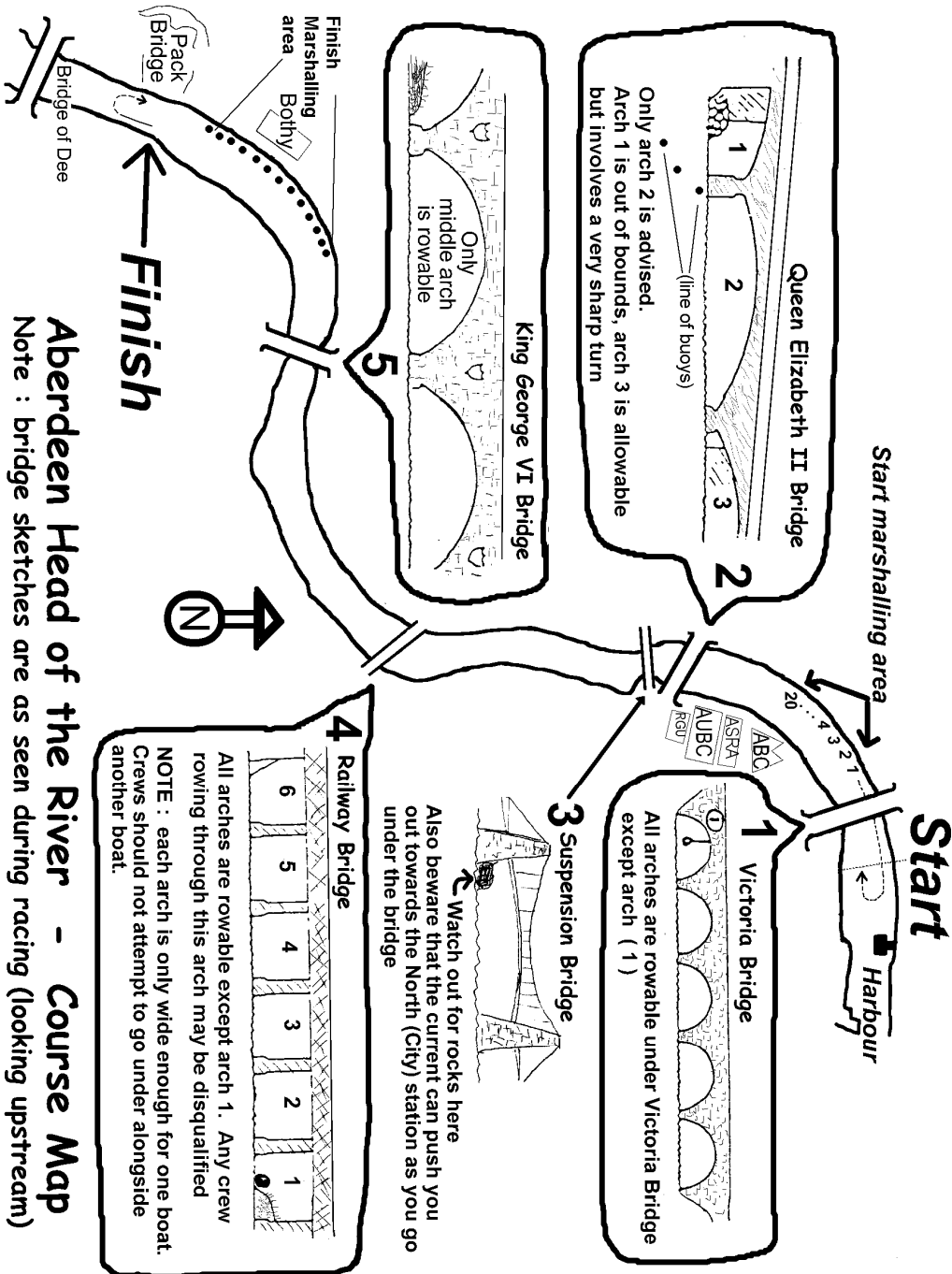

**Aberdeen Head of the River for  
 Eights and Junior Quads**  
 Saturday 9<sup>th</sup> March 2019

**RULES**

Results will be published on <http://cofd.co.uk>

- (1) **Time Penalties**
  - (a) Crews must be clear of the jetty at least 15 minutes before the start.
  - (b) Crews must be downstream of the QE2 Bridge at least 10 minutes before the start.

Any crew breaching either of these rules will be awarded a 15 second time penalty at the end of the race. If both rules are broken then a 30 second time penalty will apply. The launching area is likely to be busy at this time and it is your responsibility to allow for this.
- (2) All crews must collect their bow slot numbers from the ABC Boathouse before racing (£5 deposit per number). Numbers must be visible while racing.
- (3) Crews will gather in order on the City Bank above the Victoria Bridge with the lowest number nearest the bridge.
- (4) On the order from the marshal, all crews will strip off and then move down through the city arch of the Victoria Bridge.
- (5) On command, crews will turn round the moored starting launch by pulling harder on stroke side and holding on bow side. Make a tight turn rather than spinning.
- (6) Listen carefully to marshal's and umpire's commands in this area. Crews will be started at approximately 10 second intervals and you may be instructed to hold back if too close to the crew in front. The standardised Scottish Rowing starting procedure will be used – as crews pass the **Control Line** they will be instructed "**Crew x BUILD**". You will only have about 5 strokes before passing the **Timing Line** when you will hear the instruction "**Crew x NOW**". The timing line is just downstream of the Victoria Bridge.
- (7) The southernmost (Boathouse) arch of the Victoria Bridge is out of bounds.  
 The southernmost (Boathouse) arch of the QE Bridge is out of bounds.  
 The northernmost (City) arch of the Railway Bridge is out of bounds.  
 The northernmost (City) arch of the King George VI Bridge is out of bounds.
- (8) **Crews being overtaken must give way to faster crews and move to the outside of bends (but see rule 12)**
- (9) At the end of the race, all crews must finish on the South (Boathouse) side of the river. They must then move to the marshalling area on the North (City) side of the river. For safety reasons, **crews will only be allowed downstream of the King George VI Bridge when instructed by the marshals. Any crew breaking this rule may be liable for disqualification**
- (10) Masters events will be handicapped according to standard tables. Entrants in the **Time-Only event** will be subjected to all normal rules of racing. Any crew which is disqualified will not be informed of their time.
- (11) The race will be held under the rules of *Scottish Rowing*.
- (12) **Time-Only crews** must give way to entrants in contested events and must pass them on the outside of bends.
