

# COMMITTEE OF THE DEE

## CONSTITUTION

- 1) The Committee shall consist of three representatives chosen by each of the following rowing clubs: Aberdeen Boat Club; Aberdeen Schools Rowing Association; Aberdeen University Boat Club; Deeside Scullers; Robert Gordon University Rowing Club. Membership is open to any representative from these clubs.
- 2) The purpose of the Committee is to administer the North East Regatta annually, and to promote additional rowing events for local competition. The Committee will also provide a means of communication between the local Rowing Clubs and may make recommendations to the Clubs regarding matters involving cooperation between Clubs, and use any funds at its disposal to facilitate cooperation, subject to the agreement of the Clubs concerned.
- 3) The committee will meet annually in October after the start of the University term to elect from within the representatives a Chairman, Treasurer and Secretary. Thereafter the Committee will meet as often as necessary for its business. Minutes of such meetings will be communicated to the Member Clubs as soon as possible after the meetings. A quorum for a meeting is three members, who must be the representatives of three different Clubs.
- 4) The Committee will have powers to co-opt additional members as necessary to perform functions associated with the North East Regatta, but these members will have no rights of voting on matters which affect Member Clubs, and no say in the disbursement of funds.
- 5) The Committee is authorised by the Member Clubs to operate a bank account for the purpose of administering the North East Regatta. The Member Clubs will agree, on an annual basis, to continue this authorisation, subject to the provision by the Committee to the Clubs of a set of financial accounts for the year ending 30th September.  
At the end of the financial year any funds surplus to the Committee's needs may be disbursed equally to the Member Clubs at the Committee's discretion, and any outstanding deficit will be met by the Member Clubs on an equal basis. In the event of the Committee of the Dee being wound up, any remaining funds will be distributed between the above clubs on an equal basis.
- 6) Changes to this constitution may be proposed by a Member Club, but must be ratified by all the Member Clubs before they can be considered valid and binding.
