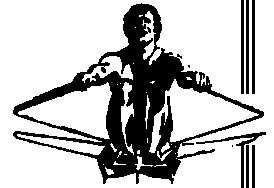

# ABERDEEN HEAD OF THE RIVER WEEKEND

(1) Crews should be on the water at least 20 minutes before the start times of their division.

(2) **Time Penalties**

- (a) Crews must be clear of the jetty at least **15 minutes** before the start of their division.  
(b) Crews must be downstream of the QE2 Bridge at least **10 minutes** before the start of their division. Any crew breaching *either* of these rules will be awarded a 15 second time penalty at the end of the race. Two penalties will apply if both rules are broken. The launching area is likely to be busy and it is your responsibility to allow for this.

(3) Medals will be awarded in all events which attract more than one entrant. No crew will be awarded more than one prize in any one division.

(4) The Races will be rowed over a 3000 metre upstream course from Victoria Bridge to Ruthrieston and will be rowed according to the rules of *Scottish Rowing (SR)*.

(5) Entry Fees (which include the *Scottish Rowing* levy) are as follows.  
Cheques should be made out to "*Committee of the Dee*".

**FOURS HOR on Saturday :** £16 for all fours (Senior, University and Junior)

**SMALL BOATS HOR on Sunday :** £4 per head for all competitors  
(coxes do not need to pay)

(6) Entries for both events close on **Sunday 8<sup>th</sup> November at 11pm.**

(8) The starting order will be drawn up according to last year's results. New entrants will be added alphabetically at the end of each event.

(9) We welcome selected boats to enter the Time-Only Events and be timed over the course. On Saturday we will only accept Fours in this event. On Sunday we will accept any boat (except eights). We will charge an administration fee of £5.00 per head for any competitor wishing to enter this event. Coxes need not pay. The starting order will be decided upon by the organising committee who have absolute discretion in this matter. Please note that this is an official event and competitors will be subject to all normal SR rules of racing. Prizes will not be offered in this event. The committee reserve the right to refuse to accept entries if we feel they would compromise the safety or organisation of the event. Times will not be published in the event of a disqualification.

(10) **NEW OFFER - Committee Boats:** Aberdeen Boat Club (ABC) are willing to loan Coxed Fours to visiting clubs from outside Aberdeen. These are good quality wooden Fours suitable for novice crews. Numbers are limited so we cannot guarantee availability but please mark any requests for this service clearly on your entry form.
