Generation Double Sculls

Competitors can enter either **Open** or **Family** Gen 2x but not both

– see Notes page for further details

53. Open Generation 2X (*One Junior and minimum 25 year age gap, do not need to be related*)

NEW (modified 28/7/25)

54. Family Generation 2X (**does not need a junior** but there must be at least a 25 year age gap and scullers must be related)

** Mixed crews must have at least 50% of rowing competitors female (but can have more)*

Competitors may enter a maximum of three events

v3 (issued 28/7/25) changes rules for Family Generation 2x event (no Junior required) and clarifies that competitors can only enter one of the Generation 2x events

Aberdeen Sprint Regatta – Notes (v3)

- All races will be rowed in accordance with Scottish Rowing rules including those relating to boat construction (heel restraints, buoyancy etc). Entry fees include the Scottish Rowing levy.
- Mixed events must have at least 50% of rowers female (but can be more).
- If only one entry is received for an event then the crew will, where possible, automatically be placed in the next higher status event unless otherwise stated at time of entry.
- Individuals can enter a **maximum of three events**.
- Masters events will be handicapped according to standard tables. Please make sure you state the Masters category of your crew at time of entry.

Entrants in the **Open Generation Double Sculls** event must include one Junior sculler and the other sculler must be at least 25 years older.

Scullers can be of either sex and do not have to be related.

Entrants in our **new Family Generation 2x** do not require a junior (*change of rule 28/7/25*) but there must be at least a 25 year age gap between the scullers.

Scullers can be of either sex and must be related.

Individuals can enter Open or Family Gen 2x but not both.

Entries must be made using the Excel spreadsheet which can be downloaded from our website. <https://cofd.co.uk> It is essential that all SR (or equivalent) licence numbers are included as these are used to detect doubling-up and allocate appropriate race times.
