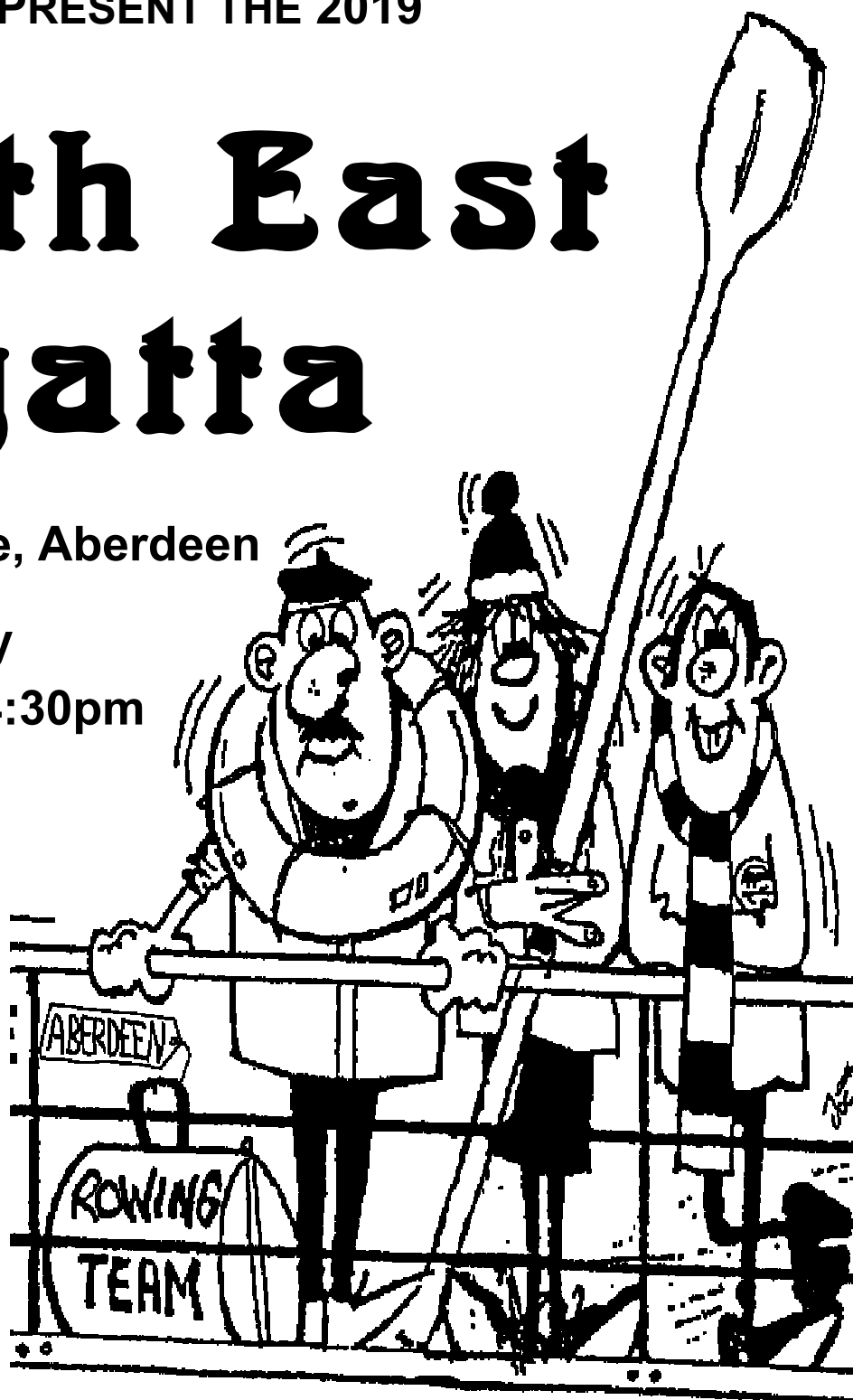

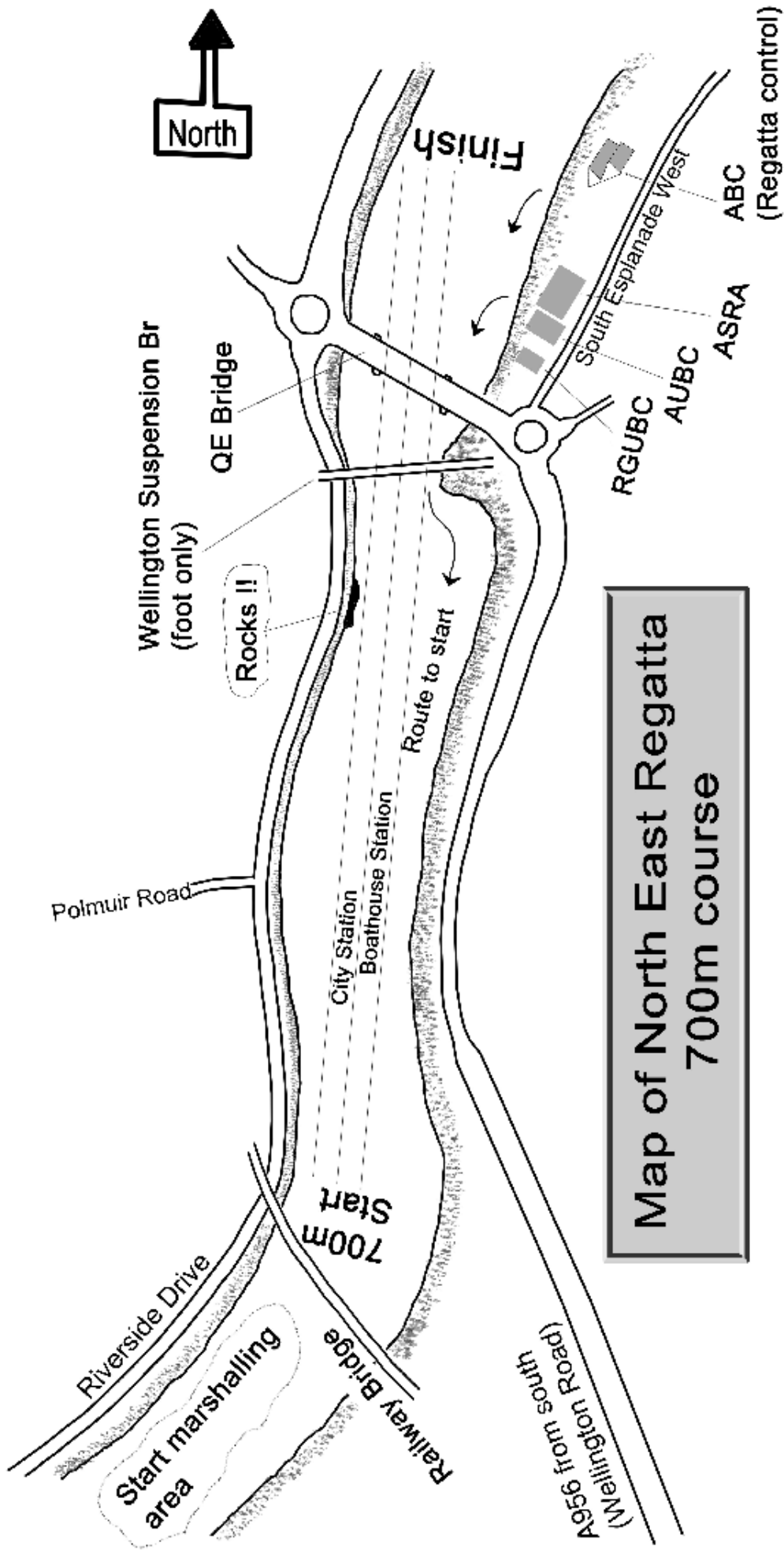

Course Details

- Crews must boat facing upstream and proceed to the bridge marshalling area. Please be careful going under the Suspension Bridge as the river is narrow here and you must watch out for crews racing downstream and **give way to them if necessary.**
- Crews must keep to the Boathouse side of the river on the way up to the start.
- Crews may be asked to turn **downstream** of the Railway Bridge if the tide is low but normally they should report to the start marshal **above** the Railway Bridge. Railway Br arches are numbered from 1 to 6 (1 is first water-arch on city side) - proceed upstream **only** through arches 4-6; come downstream **only** through arches 2 or 3 (2 is safer)
- The start is free and, in view of the downstream current, manoeuvring at the start should normally be done by backing down.
- There is a line of buoys near the finish but these do not represent the exact finish line and crews should not stop racing until instructed by the finisher. Boats and blades must pass within the correct line of buoys.
- After finishing, all crews should turn and approach a jetty as soon as possible especially if their boat or members are required for other events
- Prizegiving will take place approximately 15 minutes after the last race of each day

Local Regatta Rules

(Please also study the course map and its Notes)

- The rules of racing of *Scottish Rowing* apply to this regatta.
- Club Captains, or their representatives, must report to the Regatta Secretary before the start of the regatta. **Any crew which fails to submit a written list of crew members or has not paid its entry fee by the time of its first race will be disqualified.**
- Bow-slot numbers will be loaned to competitors upon deposit of £5 and these must be in place while racing. The deposit will be refunded on safe return of the number.
- Competitors must report to the start marshal **at least five minutes before their published race times. Crews must then stay in touch with the start marshal until they are called to the start line.** The timing of the regatta is critical and late crews will be disqualified (Aberdeen crews take note !)
- The first named crew will take the City Station (opposite the Boathouse), the second named crew will take the Boathouse Station.
- The 700m course will be used in all events. The course is in two lanes and runs downstream from a free start below the Railway Bridge. It runs in a straight line through the two bridges before the finish at the upstream end of the Aberdeen Boat Club Boathouse. Crews should finish near the City Bank and not turn the corner downstream of the QE Bridge. There are three buoys near the finish and **boats and blades must pass between the appropriate buoys, or risk disqualification.**
- The buoys near the finish do **not** represent the exact finish line and crews should not stop racing until instructed by the umpire.
- We do not have permission to row below the Victoria Bridge (downstream of the Boathouse). Any crew violating this rule is likely to be sunk and/or disqualified. Also beware that rowing above the Railway Bridge is only safe at certain states of tide - consult a local rower if in doubt.
- Mixed crews must comprise at least 50% women (but can be more, up to 100%)

Notes for Veteran Events

A handicap system will operate in all veteran events. Veteran crews must declare their status **in writing** to the secretary at least 30 minutes before their first race., otherwise they will be assumed to be Veteran A (no advantage).

The following table gives an **indication** of advantages for our 720m course. These may vary depending on conditions on the day (they are based on the standard time for a Vet A FISA World Masters crew in each category). It is based on the tables produced by Dan Davidson in May 2016.

NB HANDICAPPING WILL TAKE PLACE AT THE *FINISH*

Crews will start level, as usual, and the time differential between the first and second crews will be measured as they cross the finish line. If this time is less than the previously intimated handicap, then the crew which was second over the line will be deemed to have won the race.

Notes from last year's event

Notes from **last year's event** held on 14th April 2018

We enjoyed one of the best NERs in years. Glorious weather (bit of a breeze developed towards the end of racing but it was a welcome direct tailwind). Amazing to think that we had debated the option of cancelling the event due to concerns about entries. In the end, a huge entry from Stirling allowed for some very exciting racing against untested opposition. We also had outside entries from Inverness RC and the University of St Andrews BC. Stirling family effort secures Dee prize

The North East Regatta in Aberdeen on Saturday produced a shock result with the Championship of the Dee trophy being awarded to Stirling Rowing Club. It was 39 years ago in 1979 when this trophy last went to a rowing club from outside Aberdeen. Stirling sent a large squad to this, the main regatta in Aberdeen, and had successes across Junior, Senior (adult) and Masters (veteran) categories for both men and women. Their success was partly due to efforts from three generations of one family who were all competing. The Plank family team was led by granddad David (69) along with his son Kevin (42), and two grandchildren Rebecca (13) and Ollie (11). Sadly, David was the only family member to go home without a medal but all others won at least one event and Kevin managed to go home with four medals.

Stirling Rowing Club amassed a final tally of 98 points for the Championship of the Dee award with the locally-based Aberdeen Boat Club in close second place with 83 points. Albyn Schools Boat Club and Inverness Rowing Club tied for third place on 17 points each. The University of St Andrews Boat club had no event wins but gained 12 points by making it thorough to finals and finished ahead of Aberdeen University Boat Club who gained 10 points.

Racing over the 700m course finishing at Aberdeen Boat Club took place in ideal conditions. The next rowing competition in Aberdeen will be the Sprint Regatta on 25th August and Stirling have already thrown down the gauntlet stating they intend to return to Aberdeen to do battle at this event.
