North East and Sprint Regatta - Notes

- Races will be rowed in accordance with the rules of Scottish Rowing (SR).
Update: With permission from SR, Junior categories will **not** change on Sunday which, from the point of view of SR rules, can be regarded as the 32nd August!
- All events will be rowed over an almost-straight, two-lane course from the Railway Bridge to the Aberdeen Boat Club Boathouse. 700m on Saturday and 500m on Sunday.
- A victor ludorum competition will be run over the regatta weekend for the Championship of the Dee trophy.
- Entry fee, which includes the Scottish Rowing levy, is £5 per competitor for all events (coxes do not need to pay). We reckon this is the cheapest in UK for an Open event.

Entries close at 11pm on Thursday 22nd August

- The draw will take place at 7pm on Monday 26th August at Aberdeen Boat Club. Please provide a mobile phone number for someone who will be available during the draw to answer any questions.
- Please ensure that any boat sharing or equipment restrictions are clearly marked in the Notes section on the entry spreadsheet.
- If only one entry is received for an event, the crew will automatically be placed in the next higher status event unless otherwise stated at the time of entry.
- Doubling-up is encouraged and trebling-up is permitted but no guarantees can be given regarding race or rest times with multiple entries. Please mark all doubling-up including sharing of boats, coxes and oars. Competitors entering more than three events do so at their own risk and the committee cannot guarantee to accept these entries nor to avoid clashes of race times. Entry fees will not be refunded if competitors have to withdraw from such clashing events.
- Refreshments, snacks and bar facilities will be available each day.
- Masters events may be entered by crews of any class. If crews of different classes are drawn together then handicapping will be employed using standard tables. Confirmation of the veteran status of a crew (or sculler) must be given in writing to the secretary before the start of racing otherwise no advantage will be given.
- **Mixed** events must have at least 50% of the rowers/scullers female (can be more)
- Entrants in the **Generation Double Sculls** event must include one Junior sculler and the other sculler must be at least 25 years older. Scullers can be of either sex and do not have to be related.
- The **ABC Invitation New-rowers** event is open to ABC members who have only started rowing this year (after 1/1/2024)
