North East Regatta - Notes

- Ø Races will be rowed in accordance with the rules of Scottish Rowing (SR).
- Ø All events will be rowed over an almost-straight, two-lane 700m course from the Railway Bridge to the Aberdeen Boat Club Boathouse.
- Ø A victor ludorum competition will be run over the regatta for the Championship of the Dee trophy.
- Ø Entry fees, which includes the Scottish Rowing levy are as follows (coxes free) :-

Senior rowers	£6.00 per competitor
University or college rowers	£4.00 per competitor
Junior rowers (in any event)	£3.00 per competitor

Entries close at 10pm on Thursday 5th May

- Ø The draw will take place at 10am on Sunday 8th May at the ABC Boathouse. If you are the only entrant in an event, we will (unless you state otherwise on the entry form) try to move you to a suitable alternative event. Please provide a mobile phone number for someone who will be available during the draw to discuss this or answer any questions.
- Ø Please ensure that any boat sharing or equipment restrictions, along with doubling-up of coxes are clearly marked in the Notes section on Playwaze or emailed separately to Ron Wallace
- Ø Doubling-up is encouraged and trebling-up is permitted but no guarantees can be given regarding race or rest times with multiple entries. Please mark all doubling-up including sharing of boats, coxes and oars. Competitors entering more than three events do so at their own risk and the committee cannot guarantee to avoid clashes of race times. Entry fees will not be refunded if competitors have to withdraw from such clashing events.
- Ø Refreshments, snacks and bar facilities will be available throughout the day.
- Ø Masters events may be entered by crews of any class. If crews of different classes are drawn together then handicapping will be employed using standard tables. Confirmation of the masters status of a crew or sculler must be given in writing to the secretary before the start of racing otherwise no advantage will be given.
- Ø Mixed events must comprise at least 50% females - ie can have more women than men but not vice versa. All-female crews may enter these events.
