# Aberdeen Sprint Regatta - Notes

- All races will be rowed in accordance with *Scottish Rowing* rules and entry fees include the *Scottish Rowing* levy
- Mixed events must have at least 50% of rowers female (but could be more).
- If only one entry is received for an event then the crew will, when possible, automatically be placed in the next higher status event unless otherwise stated at time of entry.
- Individuals can enter a **maximum of three events**.
- Masters events will be handicapped according to standard tables.
- Entrants in the Generation Double Sculls event must include one Junior sculler and the other sculler must be at least 25 years older. Scullers can be of either sex and do not have to be related.
- As the only Sprint on the SR calendar, we are anticipating a large entry and it is essential that accurate crew names are provided on the Playwaze entry system (don't use dummy entries or aliases). The names on the Playwaze system are automatically transferred into our regatta sorting software and used to calculate doublings-up and allocate appropriate race times. Playwaze requires all competitors to have valid racing licences and also that those making the entries have registered on the system (which takes time) so don't leave this until the last minute!

Entries must be made online using the **Playwaze** system.
